The Poster Competition can be on any one of the following themes relating to -

Expanding quality healthcare beyond metros to bridge the urban-rural divide in India.

2. Green & Net-Zero Hospitals: Future of Sustainable Healthcare Infrastructure

Creating climate-resilient, energy-efficient healthcare facilities for a sustainable Bharat.

3. One Nation, One Health Record: Building Interoperable Digital Ecosystems

Transforming Indian healthcare through unified health records for continuity of care and national data integration.

4. Al & ML in Rural Diagnostics: Bridging the Urban-Rural Divide

Using artificial intelligence to improve diagnostic accuracy and access in underserved areas.

5. Smart Hospitals: Leveraging IoT, Automation & Blockchain for Patient Safety

Integrating smart technologies to enhance safety, efficiency, and real-time monitoring.

6. Startups Driving Innovation in Indian Healthcare Ecosystem

Showcasing Indian health-tech startups redefining accessibility, affordability, and service delivery.

7. Workforce 2047: Reskilling for the Future of Healthcare

Preparing India's healthcare workforce with future-ready skills for a rapidly evolving system.

8. Healthcare Leadership for Viksit Bharat: Vision, Values & Execution

Rules:

- 1. The poster and abstract containing 200 words must be submitted, and team must register before the deadline i.e. 05 September 2025.
- 2. Maximum 3 participants are allowed per poster.
- 3. The Topic of poster and theme should be clearly mentioned at the Top Margin of the Poster.
- 4. Total time of 5 minutes (3 Mins presentation + 2 Min Q&A) will be given per team to present/explain the poster.
- 5. Questions will be posed by judges for 2 minutes.

CONTENT STRUCTURE

Essential Sections:

- Title & Author Info Clear title, your name, institution
- Abstract Brief overview of question, methods, and findings (150-200 words)
- Introduction Problem statement and context
- Methods Concise description of your approach
- Results Key findings with graphs, charts, and images
- Discussion Interpretation and implications
- Conclusions Main takeaways
- References Key sources cited

Design Basics

Layout:

- Left-to-right, top-to-bottom flow
- Use white space and consistent margins
- Standard size

Typography:

- Readable fonts (Arial, Helvetica, Calibri)
- High contrast between text and background

Visuals:



- 20% text, 80% visuals
- High-quality images (300 DPI)
- Consistent colour scheme (3-4 colours max)
- Clear captions and labels

Presentation Tips

Preparation:

- Practice 2-3 minute elevator pitch
- Prepare for common/ specific questions
- Bring business cards or contact info
- Dress professionally

Content Guidelines:

- Use clear, concise language
- Avoid jargon or define technical terms
- Tell a coherent story
- Make main message obvious

Common Mistakes to Avoid

- Too much text
- Poor image quality
- Inconsistent design
- Unclear narrative
- Unreadable fonts (must be visible from 3-4 feet)
- Crowded layout
